Greetings, my name is Kay Flavell. Since 2001 I have been living in the old concrete house of Normandell (now New Pacific Studio) in Kaiparoro and have recently published <u>Living in Kaiparoro</u>, telling the stories of some of the families of this area. Over the next three years, I am working on piecing together stories and photos of the schools, families and farms of the Mauriceville and Hastwell district, and invite you to contact me at 354-8441 or to drop in to NPS if you can help me with this work.

I have already talked about some of this material in ch. 4 of the above book, which mentions Danish and Norwegian connections with Kaiparoro (Isaksons of North Road, and Larsens of West Road.)

I have also begun to circulate it in Masterton and new signatures include those of Ron and Pat Neighbours, Gray Nelson and John and Janice Osborne.

Friends of Mauriceville is designed to supplement existing organizations in the district. As a charitable organization with a cultural aim, it will apply for funds for various projects. These will include artist residencies at New Pacific Studio and a public art project called Whispering Roads, to be developed in conjunction with Aratoi Museum of Art and History and Wairarapa artists and writers over the next few years.

I hope you will give your support to this work and help keep alive the memories of this fascinating district. Annual membership will be \$10 per family. The first \$100 will go to pay the incorporation fee.
